WOOLSTON PARISH COUNCIL – 25 JANUARY 2023 REPORT OF THE CLERK BUDGET AND PARISH PRECEPT 2023-24

The Council is requested to determine the budget and parish precept for 2023-24.

A summary of the estimated net expenditure for 2023-24 is given below. A copy of the draft budget for each committee has been supplied.

The Council agreed on 7 December 2022 that the budget should be prepared on a no growth basis.

Environment and Amenities

Environmental works and events 13800 Battery Lane Allotment Site 500

Martinscroft Village Green

The Council have authorised an inspection on trees on the southern length of the Green. This is to allow a report to be prepared on work to trees overhanging the highway.

The agreed scheme for traffic calming measures included recognition of maintenance work. Provision has been made for works e.g., tree works, road maintenance and the periodic cleaning of the cenotaph.

Hillock Lane amenity area

Liaison is continuing with the Borough Council on use of the amenity area as part of a scheme for Woolston Playing Fields. Until this information is received consideration of environmental improvement works to the amenity area has been halted.

Provision has been made for unplanned works e.g., tree works and participation in any scheme promoted by the Borough Council.

Woolston Playing Fields

Responsibility for the management of the playing fields has been with the Borough Council from 1 September 2012. No further discussions have been held with the Borough Council on the future use and management of the playing fields and the associated impact on the amenity area. Provision has been made for participation in any scheme promoted by the Borough Council.

Election costs provision

Provision has been made for the repayment of the costs of elections based on the policy agreed by the Borough Council to have the option of repayment by instalment.

Friends of Woolston Park

Provision of has been included in the draft budget for Community Events, as in previous years. Separate provision is made for works by the Group in the park.

Road safety scheme

Provision has been made for a road safety scheme to assist in speed control of vehicles. This has been delayed to allow a scheme to be developed in liaison with the Borough Council and the Police.

Facilities for young people

The Council has considered supporting facilities for young people subject to consultation with other agencies and young people in the parish. The Council has received reports of possible contributions from the Police and Crime Commissioner for Cheshire. Provision has been made for a contribution to a scheme.

Old Billy scheme - New Cut Canal

The Council has given approval to a scheme along the New Cut Canal to celebrate the life of Old Billy, the World's oldest working horse. Culture Warrington are leading on the development of the scheme, and it is intended that physical works will be installed this year. The Council have agreed to work in partnership with the Borough Council in the implementation of the scheme. Liaison is to take place with the New Cut Heritage and Ecology Trail Group and the Poulton with Fearnhead Parish Council when the draft artwork has been received from Culture Warrington.

Level of Precept

The precept for 2022-23 was £26133 giving an amount of £11.34 for a Band D property. A precept of £26181 using the notified tax base for 2023-24 would give an estimated amount of £11.34 for a Band D property. This would meet the criteria set by the Council for a no growth budget cost as applied in determining the precept for 2022-23.
